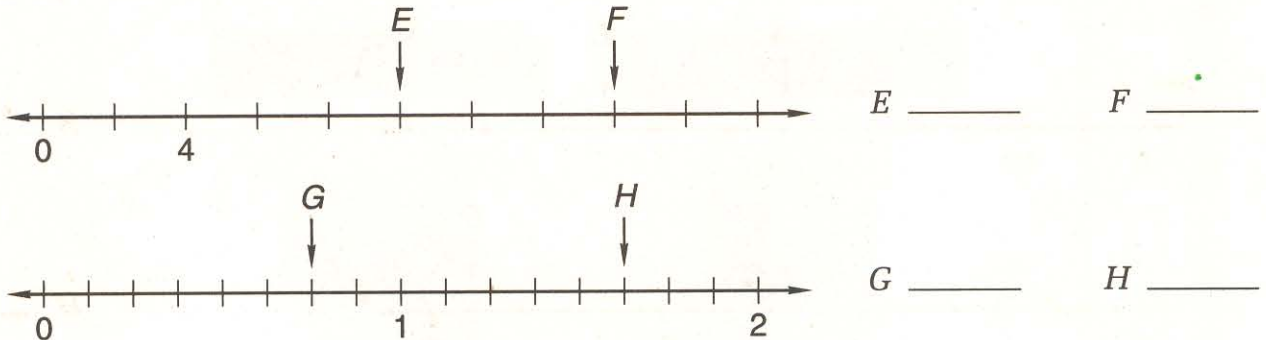

2. Fill in the missing numbers on these number lines. Where are *E*, *F*, *G*, and *H* pointing?



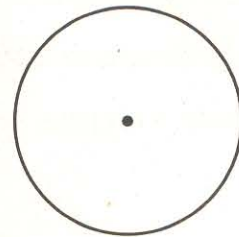
